

Tuesday After School Supervision.

We are excited to offer after school supervision at Castle Cove Public school hall on Tuesday afternoons for our students. To be eligible to enroll in our after school supervision group students must be enrolled in our 3:45pm Ballet class on Tuesday afternoons.

How it works

Miss Meghan will be waiting at the meeting point on Tuesday afternoons.

Students must make their own way straight from their classrooms to the meeting point.

We will then walk (as a group) over the road to the school hall.

Miss Meghan will then send students to the bathrooms or behind the dividers in the hall to get changed (students choose where they are most comfortable getting changed).

Students will be asked to make their way straight back to the hall so we can sit together and chat about their day while they eat their afternoon tea.

We will be ready to start ballet at 3:45pm.

At the time of printing (November 2018) a meeting spot has not yet been chosen for 2019.

We will send an email in January to all families enrolled in this group, with clear instructions on where we will meet. Miss Meghan will also call all families the week before class starts to ensure that your child knows where to meet her when the bell rings.

Kindergarten parents, for the afternoon of your child's first dance class we kindly ask that you arrange for a parent or guardian to pick your child up from their classroom, bring them to the meeting point and walk with us (as a group) to the hall. It is our experience that having a parent/carer with them the first time is the safest way to ensure your child knows where to go and to help your child feel confident. This will set them up for success in our classes for the rest of the year. If you cannot organise this, please do not worry. Your child's teacher (Miss Meghan) is very experienced with this age group and is a mum herself.

Year One parents, we would also love to meet you at the first afternoon if you like. We generally find our Year One students are confident finding their way to us.

What to pack for your dancer on Tuesdays

- Dance clothes to get changed into.
- Dance shoes
- An extra bag for their school shoes (if their school shoes do not fit in their school bag)
- Afternoon Tea
- Water Bottle

What happens if my child is away?

Parents are asked to kindly notify Miss Meghan if your child is absent from school on any Tuesday via TEXT to 0421571144. Please ensure you text your child's full name. Example: 'Meghan London is absent from school today, so will not be at the hall this afternoon.'

Safety

Safety is always our number one priority. If your child is not at the meeting point by 3:35pm you will be notified via phone call. The school office will be notified. The police will be called if your child cannot be located in their classroom, the toilets, the path between their classroom and the school hall or the school office.

Behavioral Expectations

The safety of our students is always our number one priority; it is with this in mind that we expect the same level of behavior that is expected at in the classroom at school. Students must listen to staff, follow instructions and the rules set out by the teachers.

If any student from the After School Supervision Group does not meet our behavioral expectations, we reserve the right to refuse that student the privilege of being part of this group. No second chances will be given to any student who is not following our safety instructions and who is deemed not capable of getting themselves from their classroom to the meeting point in a timely manner. Class finishes at 3:25pm. It is our expectation that students should be sighted by staff at the meeting point by 3:30pm.
